THE SCOPE of the redevelopment of 200-222 King's Road has expanded, with the site extended to 196-222 King's Road. Due to the resolution of lease issues, the adjoining land

incorporating Regal House – which includes Waitrose – and Friese Green House (pictured) has been added to the site. Cadogan is proposing a new retail-led mixed use development, featuring retail, residential and office space and a new pub and cinema. Waitrose will remain in its current location and will continue to trade throughout the works. A planning application is expected to be submitted in late September or early October, with a final post-submission public exhibition showing the plans due to be held in October.
